### **2 Rules**

The following will apply -

- The World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2017
- The IRC 2017 Rules
- The Cruiser Handicap Rating Scheme
- The Notice Of Race (unless amended by the Sailing Instructions)
- The Sailing Instructions

In case of conflict between any of the above, succeeding items take precedence.

### **3 Advertising**

The races are designated as "Category C".

### **4 Eligibility and Entry**

- 4.1 The Regatta will have the following divisions and classes:  
Racing Class - Keelboats with a current 2017 IRC Rating.  
Cruising Class - Keelboats with a Cruiser Handicap Rating  
Multihull Class – Ocean Multihulls with a Cruiser Handicap Rating  
(Boats without a Rating will be allocated a Rating under the Cruiser Handicap System based on the boat's information provided)
- 4.2 Classes may be divided or combined subject to the number of entries in a class.
- 4.3 Classes for individual boats will be recognized subject to a minimum number of three entrants in that class.
- 4.4 Boats may enter by completing the accompanying entry form (including the Handicap Measurement Form if one has not yet been submitted) and sending it by email to [contact@subicsailing.com](mailto:contact@subicsailing.com) no later than Wednesday 6th June 2017. The organizers would appreciate any advance expressions of interest, to assist with event planning.
- 4.5 Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Committee with the payment of an additional late entry fee.
- 4.6 The organizers reserve the right to refuse entry to any boat or person.(RRS 76)

## **5 Fees**

- Entry Fee for keelboat/multihull classes is P2,500.  
The Crew Fee P750. (Fees will be payable at Registration.)

## **6 Classification**

The ISAF Sailor's Classification Code will not apply.

### **10.1 The Low Point Scoring System will apply.**

## **11 Prizes**

Prizes will be presented to boats finishing 1-2-3 on corrected time in each class in each race as well as 1-2-3 in each class for the whole series.

## **12 Berthing**

Watercraft Ventures will provide FOC berthing on first come first served basis or free mooring at the Lighthouse Marina Resort mooring berths (boat to shore ferry service to be provided) for competing visiting yachts. Arrangements should be confirmed beforehand with the organizers.
